News International, publishers of The Times, The Sunday Times, The Sun and News of the World, undertook a redevelopment of its printing facilities on 3 sites, Broxbourne, Liverpool and Glasgow. The largest of these sites was a new 27,250 square metre development at Broxbourne near the M25.

PCS was awarded the contract to construct a 4 hour fire wall to separate the paper store from the printing facilities. The wall was in excess of 245m long and 25m high formed from 200mm thick autoclaved concrete panels.

Carillion achieved a Gold Award under the Considerate Contractors Scheme for the development.
